# TASTE OF PATIENCE



Located in the western part of the Zöbinger Heiligenstein, the vineyard is surrounded by peach and quince trees, with the vines embedded between narrow handcrafted stone terraces and stone huts. Our densely planted old-vine Riesling are rooted in mineral-rich soils embedded in over 270 million year old Permian rock. The plots are so steep that only people and horses can cultivate them in their most original form, producing wines with the highest ripeness potential.

## RIED HEILIGENSTEIN - ROTFELS<sup>1</sup><sub>WR</sub>

On the east side of the Zöbinger Heiligenstein, the 270 million year old desert sandstone becomes darker and redder. This striking characteristic is reflected in the single vineyards name "Rotfels" which translates into red rock. The higher clay content in the topsoil provide the vines with sufficient moisture, even during dry periods - this supports the harmonious development of the grapes.



A wine grown around a small spring on million-year-old Permian rock situated on the Heiligenstein. The grapes grown in this unique area are vinified into a very special interpretation of a Heiligenstein wine. A wine aged for 18 months on the lees in oak barrels, unfiltered.
